To Whom It May Concern:

RoHS

To the best of our knowledge the substances listed in article 4 point 1 of 2002/95/EC (RoHS) are not intentionally used in Sharpmark standard cut sheet products.

Based on incidental testing and confirmations from suppliers, the concentration limits of these substances in Sharpmark standard cut sheet products will not exceed the demands as established in an amendment of 2002/95/EC, 2005/615/EC.

For the purposes of Article 5(1)(a) of 2005/615/EC, a maximum concentration value of 0.1 % by weight in homogeneous materials for lead, mercury, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) and polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) and of 0.01 % by weight in homogeneous materials for cadmium shall be tolerated.
